



DEWAN FILHARMONIK PFTRONAS

Dewan Filharmonik PETRONAS (DFP) is Malaysia's first concert hall dedicated to classical music. Located at the PETRONAS Twin Towers, it was officially opened on 17 August 1998 by the Patron of the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO), YABhq. Tun Dr. Siti Hasmah Haji Mohd Ali and Prime Minister, Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad.

Designed by Cesar Pelli, the hall takes its inspiration from the traditional shoe-box shape of the great 19th century European concert halls with the magnificent Klais Pipe Organ providing a spectacular backdrop to the stage.

The hall seats 920 people at one time which includes box seats, corporate suites and a royal suite. Acoustics experts Kirkegaard & Associates have incorporated unique acoustical devices into its design to maximize the hall's natural qualities.

DFP plays an integral part in the music and cultural landscape of the city of Kuala Lumpur and Malaysia. It continues to enthral audiences since the day it first opened its doors. Among renowned Malaysian artists who have mesmerized audiences at DFP include SM Salim, Sheila Majid, M Nasir, Siti Nurhaliza, Hattan, Jamal Abdillah, Khadijah Ibrahim, Ramli Sarip, Aishah, Ella, Yuna, Faizal Tahir, Dayang Nurfaizah, Aubrey Suwito, Akim, Hazama, Hujan and Misha Omar among others.

International superstars who have graced the stage are Harry Connick Jr., Diana Krall, Anoushka Shankar, Laura Fygi, Zakir Hussain, Larry Carlton, Harvey Malaihollo, Ruth Sahanaya, and Judika.

World renowned orchestras that have performed here include the New York Philharmonic, Philadelphia Orchestra, BBC Symphony, and Vienna Symphony.

Beyond classical music, DFP has hosted ensembles of jazz and world music genres such as the Count Basie Orchestra, Yellowjackets, Ladysmith Black Mambazo, Mezzoforte, Igudesman & Joo, Pink Martini, and Gotan Project.

DFP has also been the venue for many local and international cultural performances, corporate events and film recording. Some of the clients that DFP have worked with are PETRONAS, UMW Toyota, Netflix, Warnakala, Allianz Malaysia, SP Setia, Embassy of The Republic of Korea, Embassy of Japan, MCKK Foundation, Universiti Teknologi PETRONAS (UTP) and The Japan Foundation, Kuala Lumpur.

DFP's success is attributed to its exceptional architectural design, superior acoustics, recording studio modelled after the legendary Abbey Road Studios. As the first purpose-built concert hall in Malaysia, DFP will continue to become the premier iconic hall with diverse music and cultural offerings to create unique experience for all.

About The Music

Jo's music genre is a wide range of soul, pop, rock and R&B. As an independent solo artist, her first showcase was at Laundry Bar, The Curve in 2013 when she was 19. She has since performed at various prestigious venues and festivals in Malaysia and America. She has an all-girl band with her sisters (pianist Jermaine and violinist Jovian) called Jiwang Sisters and they play nostalgic covers as well as originals. Jo's EP Jocelyn Lixian was released in 2014. She has since released four singles; Lie with Me (2017), Die at Midnight (2017), No One But You (2018) and Lovesick (2021), all available on Spotify, Apple Music and other digital platforms. Last year, she released single Dao Guo Mama.

MARDIANA

Mardiana, also known by her nickname Mars, is a 25-year-old Malaysian singer, songwriter and music producer. Passionate about creating electronic pop music, she started composing from an early age. Her music background in classical piano is the backbone of her ability to craft an immersive musical experience, both sonically and lyrically.

Following the release of her 10-track self-written debut album *Don't Cry For Me* (2023), the title track has garnered praises from international music publications such as Notion, Fame Magazine, C-Heads and Lock Magazine. The songs can be heard on radio stations nationwide especially *Please Just Stay In Love*, a nostalgia-inspired, dreamy synth-pop track. Holding authenticity close to heart, she embarks on her continuous mission to connect with wide audiences through music. She has performed at Out of The World Water & Music Festival, RIUH In the City, The Exchange TRX and Jumpstart Festival 2024.

Her songs are featured across Spotify editorial playlists such as New Music Friday and Women of Malaysia. In October 2024, she released her self-produced album *PLAYER 1* which consists of 9 electronic and experimental tracks.


